Abstract: The collection contains materials collected by Jesús Castillo Ruiz. Ruiz participated in the UC Berkeley Third World Liberation Front (Twlf) strike in 1968 – 1969 and was subsequently elected to the UC Berkeley Academic Senate between 1969 and 1972 on a progressive student slate. This collection contains materials from the Twlf strike, news coverage of social movements in the Bay Area (especially 1968 – 1970) and ASUC Berkeley resolutions, meeting minutes and student campaign materials. There is also a comprehensive set of Daily Cal newspapers covering Fall 1968 into Spring 1969 a critical period of student organizing and activism on UC Berkeley's campus.

Between 1977 and 1984, Jesús was an active member of the Mexican American Political Association (Santa Clara Valley Chapter) but also engaged in statewide organizational work to build and mobilizing Mexican American political power. Related materials include comprehensive internal documentation of the Mexican American Political Association work – with a primary focus on the Santa Clara chapter but also coverage of larger statewide work. This documentation includes correspondence; organizational periodicals and chapter newsletters; press releases; meeting agendas, minutes, resolutions; campaign endorsements; binders of photos; and materials originating from their political work.

Languages Represented: Collection materials are in English and Spanish.
